PARENTS REQUIREMENTS TO ACCESS

- 1** Parents/carers are strictly forbidden to enter the school. Parents and carers will take their children to the registration point outside the gates where they will be met by a member of the staff.
- 2** All parents/carers will be responsible to respect the precautionary distance (1,5-2 metres) whilst waiting to access the school.
- 3** All entrance to the school will be done gradually and timings will be previously assigned by the school. All parents/carers will be responsible to respect their assigned entrance time and to evacuate the school grounds as soon as their children are inside.
- 4** School staff will meet children at the designated entrance points and will grant access after monitoring their body temperature. Children with a temperature superior to 37° won't be allowed to access the school.
- 5** Parents/carers and children are not allowed to gather for socialising within the school grounds and especially at the school entrance. Ensure that the times to collect and pick up are swift enough.
- 6** Parents/carers are entirely responsible for the strict following of all of the requirements and to make sure children are fit to attend school.

CHILDREN'S ENTRY REQUIREMENTS



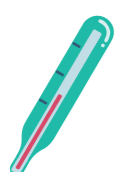
Absence of any symptomatology related to COVID19 (fever, cough, difficulties breathing, discomfort, diarrhea...) or any other infectious symptoms.



Not to have been in contact or close contact with a confirmed positive or suspected person that has had symptoms related during/prior 14 days.



Proof of all vaccinations being up to date.



At the entrance your child/children will be attended by a member of the staff, who will take their temperature. If their temperature exceeds 37°, they will not be allowed access to the school.



Once children access the school premises they will be asked to wash their hands with hydroalcoholic gel. This will be repeated every two hours with water and soap, before and after snack time, before and after going to the toilet and once they are ready to leave the school.



Face masks are recommended but not compulsory, unless children are not able to keep the security distance of 1,5-2 meters.
